



### **Call for Papers: Future of Dentistry Award 2023**

(Varna, 25/11/2022) The opportunity for dental graduates: The Future of Dentistry Award 2023 is now open. For the 7th time, DentaprimE dental clinic (Varna/London) is awarding this prize for scientific work to support and fund young graduates in their research.

The Future of Dentistry Award includes prize money of 3,000 euros.

The award is given for scientific papers completed in the field of implantology, implant prosthetics and dental stem cell research. Graduates of European universities are eligible to participate. The paper may be written by one author or a group of authors.

To apply, please send us your paper including a maximum five-page abstract and a curriculum vitae. Papers must be written in German or English. Acceptable formats are unpublished and published papers. A publication must not date back more than two years.
